Setting Up Your Phone

Welcome to Verizon Wireless You're now part of a growing movement that's about speed, signal and strength. This guide will show you how to set up and use your phone. access special features, and find help.

Step 1. Remove the Back Cover

Place your fingernail in the cutout at the bottom of the phone and pop the cover off the phone.



Step 2. Insert the Battery

Insert the battery, making sure to align the gold contacts. Press down gently to secure the battery.



Step 3. Replace the Back Cover

Place the back cover over the back of the phone and press down along the edges to secure it.



Step 4. Charge the Phone

Before turning on your phone, charge it fully

- . Connect the USB cable to the charger adapter.
- 2. Plug the other end of the USB cable to the USB/Charging Port and the charger adapter into an electrical outlet.

CAUTION! Please use only an approved charger to charge your phone. Improper handling of the charging port, as well as the use of an incompatible charger, may cause damage to your device and yoid the warranty.



NOTE: Please make sure that the " $\sqrt[4]{}$ " side faces up before inserting a charger or USB cable into the USB/Charging Port of your phone.

Using Your Phone

Turning Your Phone On/Off



Press and hold the **Power/END kev** to turn vour phone on.



Press and hold the **Power/END key** to turn vour phone off.

Home Screen

Relow is the default Home screen To access the options at the bottom, use the Left and Right Select keys and the OK kev ĸ.





Making a Call

Open the phone and enter the phone number using the keypad.

Press the SEND key to dial the numher

Press the **Power/END key** to end the call

NOTE: Your phone has a Voice Commands feature that also lets you make calls by saving a phone number or Contact name To access it press the Voice Commands key (TRU) and say **Call** followed by the name or number

Receiving a Call

When the phone rings or vibrates, you can answer the call by simply opening the phone. If the phone is already open, answer the call by pressing any key.

To end the call, simply close the phone or press the **Power/END kev**.

To add more answer options, press the OK key MENU. Then select Settings & Tools > Call Settings > Answer Options and unmark Flip Open.

Then, when the phone rings, you will be able to.

Oujet Mute the ringing or vibration for a call by pressing the Left Select kev.

- Ignore Send the call directly to Voice Mail by pressing the Right Select key
- **TEXT** End the call and send a quick text message to the caller by pressing the OK key

Setting Up Voice Mail

- Dial *86 and press the SEND key who
- 2. Follow the setup instructions.

Checking Voice Mail

From your phone:

- 1. Dial *86 and press the SEND key .
- Follow the instructions.

From other phones:

- 1. Dial vour wireless number.
- 2. When you hear the greeting, press # to interrupt.
- 3. Follow the instructions.

NOTE: Voice mailboxes not set up within 45 days will be canceled. Your voice mailbox is not password protected until you create a password by following the setup tutorial.

Text Messaging

Send text, picture and voice messages from your phone. Depending on the type of message you choose to send, you can also

attach files to your messages including pictures, sounds, voice recordings and name cards.

- . Open the phone and press the OK key OK MENU
- Press ≥ Messaging.
- 3. Press **I New Message**.
- 4 Press the **OK key** or to access the text field
- 5. Use the keypad to enter your message.
- 6 Press the OK key SEND

Taking Photos

Take digital pictures with your phone.

- . Open the phone and press the OK key OK MENU
- 2 Press SM Media Center
- 3 Press 4 Pictures
- 4 Press **≥**∞ Take Picture
- 5. Set the brightness by pressing the Directional key up and down, zoom by pressing the Directional key left and right, and press the **Right** Select key Options to change other settings.

NOTE: Zoom is not available at the highest resolution.

Turning Bluetooth On/Off

To turn your phone's Bluetooth® On/Off:

- 1. Open the phone and press the **OK key** Second Secon
- Press 🔤 Settings & Tools.
- Press Be Bluetooth Menu 2
- 4. Press the Left Select key Turn On.

NOTE: By default, your device's Bluetooth[®] is turned off.

Backup AssistantSM

You can save your phone's address book to a secure website. If your phone is lost or damaged, or if you upgrade to a new phone. Backup Assistant will restore your contacts. Go to verizonwireless.com/ baplus.

Take the Internet with you on the go. You can reach the latest news, weather and stock reports from your phone.

- Open the phone and press the OK key MENU
- Press 4 Internet to start surfing the web.
