Bluetooth® Pairing

Cut the cords and go wireless! The UX300 enhances your experience with the convenience of Bluetooth technology.

- 1. Set your Bluetooth accessory into pairing mode.*
- Press up on the Navigation Key, then select Paired Devices (1).
- 3. Press the Left Soft Key for Search. When prompted to turn on Bluetooth, press or on the keypad.
- 4. Press or to begin a new search.
- 5. Once the Bluetooth device has been found, highlight it and press or for **Pair**.
- 6. Enter the passcode* (typically "0000" 4 zeroes) and press or .
- 7. Press or to connect with the device.

*Refer to your Bluetooth accessory's user guide for information about initiating pairing mode and the passcode.



Taking a Picture

Capture the moment! The UX300's VGA camera is so easy to use that you won't miss a thing.

Flip Open

- 1. Press and *hold* the side **E** Key.
- Press up or down on the Navigation Key to zoom.* Press left or right to adjust the brightness. To adjust other camera options, press the Right Soft Key for Options.
- 3. Press **1** to take a picture.

Flip Closed

- 1. Press and *hold*, then quickly press the side **Volume Keys**.
- 2. Press **1** to take a picture.

Restricting Calls

Lending your phone to a friend or colleague? The UX300 allows you the freedom to restrict features for the ultimate in flexibility.

- Press the Left Soft Key for Menu, then select Settings (9) and Security (3).
- 2. Enter the lock code (by default, the last four digits of your phone number) and press or.
- 3. Select Restrictions (2), then Calls (1).
- Select a restriction and press OK
