## Your phone

Most of what you need can be accessed from the Home screen canvases and three simple kevs on the front of the device:

- Menu Key: Open available menu options.
- Home Key: Go to the Home screen.
- Back Key: Go back one screen or menu.



# Start

## Initial setup

The first time you turn on your phone, a setup wizard guides you through configuring various settings and signing in to your Google account. If you don't have one, don't worry, the wizard will help you create one.

NOTE This phone supports apps and services that use a lot of data, so make sure your data plan meets your needs. Contact your service provider for details.



#### Touch tips Home screen

It's all in the touch:

- Touch: Choose an icon or option.
- Touch & Hold: Open available options.
- Drag: Scroll or move slowly.
- . Flick: Scroll or move quickly.
- Pinch-to-zoom: Get a closer look at Google Maps™, web pages, or photos.

To access the Email app, touch Email from the Home screen.


To add email accounts, choose Microsoft Exchange for Microsoft™ Exchange work email (for settings, ask your IT administrator) or Other for most other accounts (for settings, ask the account provider).



## Media

- Photos: To take a photo, touch Camera from the Home screen.
- Videos: From the Home screen, touch Camera > Mode switch . To record a video, touch To stop recording, touch
- To see the photos and videos vou've taken. from the Home screen, touch Apps ==> Gallery 🜉.
- Music: From the Home screen, touch > Music In to open your music library and select what you want to play.



## Web & maps

Browse, download, and search (of course), Find where you are or where you're going.

- Browser: Touch Browser if from the Home screen and surf using the super fast 4G and Wi-Fi connections.
- Google Maps™: From the Home screen, touch ..... > Maps 🎊 to use the Google Maps you know and love.



# Apps

All your apps, all together:

- Menu: To open the Apps screen, touch from the Home screen. To close the Apps screen, press Home -
- screen and enter the app name.
- More: Touch Play Store rfrom the Home screen to download your favorites.





## Wireless

Lose the wires—from the Home screen, touch Menu = > System settings > WIRELESS & NETWORKS section.

- Bluetooth™: For handsfree calls and wireless music, touch Bluetooth and connect to your accessory.
- · Wi-Fi: For fast internet access, touch Wi-Fi and connect to a home, office, or hotspot network. For advanced settings, touch Menu > Advanced.

## QuickMemo™

Use QuickMemo to easily and efficiently create memos during a call, with a saved picture or on the current phone screen.

1. While viewing the screen you want to capture and create a memo on, press the QuickMemo Key on the left side of the phone.


